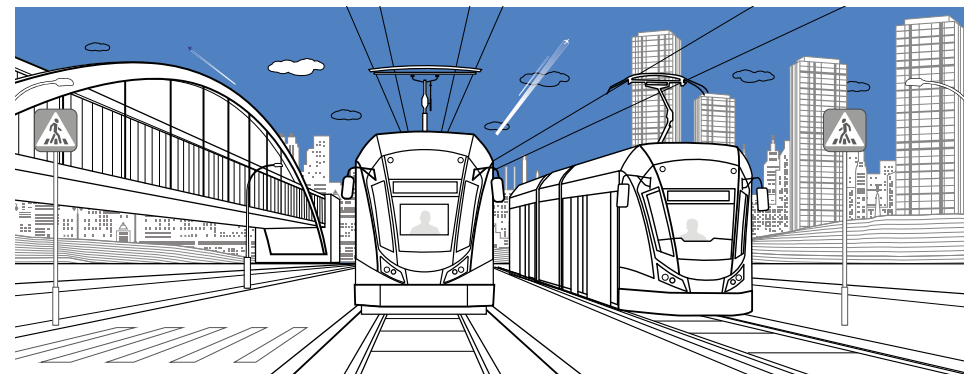

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TIPS FOR MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVERS



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To avoid incidents and ensure smooth traffic flow, it is essential to follow these rules when driving near tram tracks:

TO KEEP IN MIND

- **Tram priority:** The tram always has the right of way. You must respect it at all times.
- **Do not block the tramway:** Never obstruct the tram's path. Do not stop, park, or drive on its platform. Only emergency vehicles may use it when necessary.

- **Crossings and turns:** If you need to cross the tramway, do so carefully and pay attention to road signs and traffic lights
- **Entries and exits:** When entering or leaving a garage or joining a street near the tram tracks, stay alert and drive only through permitted areas.



Tram warning

Indicates the proximity of a tram crossing.
Remember: the tram ALWAYS has priority.



Pedestrian crossing prohibited

Indicates areas, streets, or crossings where pedestrians are not allowed to pass.



No left turn



No right turn



No entry



Yellow grid markings on the pavement indicate tram crossings.

Stopping any vehicle on them is prohibited.



Height limit

Prohibits the passage of vehicles exceeding the indicated height.



No vehicles allowed

Entry is prohibited to all vehicles.



STOP

Indicates that you must come to a complete stop at intersections before proceeding.



Give way

Indicates the obligation to yield to other vehicles at intersections or when merging.
