### No pedestrian crossing

If you see this sign, you must not cross on foot.




#### No entry

No right turn

When you see this sign, you may not travel in that direction.



#### No vehicles

No vehicle may pass when you see this sign.



#### Yield

In front of this sign. you don't have priority and must wait for your turn to pass.

# IF YOU ARE WALKING:

- The tram is the king of the street! It always has priority, even if there's no traffic light. Let it go first!
- Cross only at zebra crossings. Don't walk on the tracks, it's dangerous! And before crossing, always look both ways, like an owl!
- Listen for the bell. The tram rings a bell to let you know it's coming. Take off your headphones and keep your phone in your pocket so you can hear it.
- Wait in a safe place. When you're at the stop, stay behind the safety line. **That way you'll be safe!**

# IF YOU'RE ON A BIKE OR SCOOTER:

- The tracks are for trams only! Don't ride your bike or scooter on them. Use the special bike lanes or the street.
- Cross very carefully. If you need to cross the tracks, look carefully and don't get your wheels stuck in the rails. That way you won't fall!
- Don't stop on the way. Never stand still or stop on the tram tracks. **The tram can't stop as quickly** as a car!
